

THE CITY OF STEINBACH



Steinbach, a city of about 12,500 population, is located 55 kilometers southeast of Winnipeg at the junction of Highways 12 and 52. The growing community serves as a regional trading centre for some 50,000 people throughout southeastern Manitoba. While some of Steinbach's earlier industries were agriculturally based, most have expanded and diversified to the extent they are now manufacturing products sold nationally and abroad.

Major employers in the city include firms producing windows, millwork, printed materials and metal products. Other plants turn out pre-cast concrete products and pharmaceuticals.

In the summer, residents can enjoy the beauty and challenge of the very scenic Steinbach Fly-in 18 hole golf course. Take a walk on the many walking routes with numerous rest areas along the way or tour the Mennonite Heritage Village museum.

Residents can enjoy a tennis match or play for their ball or soccer team at the community parks.

For visitors accommodations there are several hospitality motels/hotel and a campground facility with electric hook-ups.

In winter, residents can take a refreshing swim in the Aquatic Centre, skate, play hockey or ringette, curl, bowl, play basketball or volleyball or be part of the cheering section as their favorite team take to the ice

or school gymnasiums. Cross country skiing and snowmobile enthusiasts can enjoy these pursuits in the Steinbach area.

Year-round facilities include the Aquatic Centre, bowling alley and school gymnasiums.

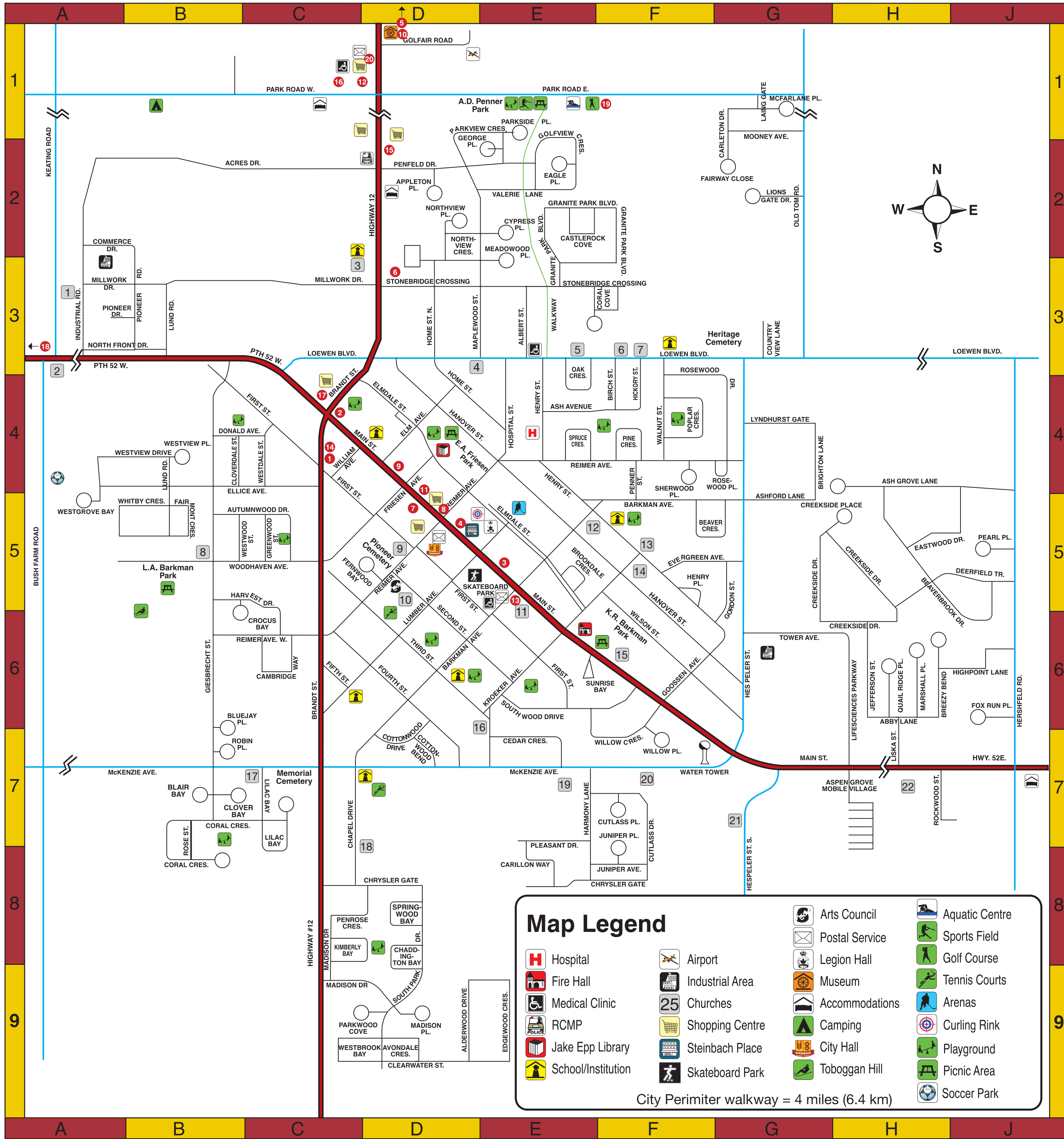
Steinbach's Bethesda Health Service embraces a 64 bed acute care facility, 60 bed personal care home and 20 bed rehabilitation unit. Steinbach also has a 60 bed nursing home.

Five public schools and three private institutions offer quality education to 4,030 students in the community. (Largest of the schools is the regional vocational complex offering both academic and job-oriented courses to 1217 students.)

Envision Community Living, provides educational and training programs for the adult mentally challenged.
